

ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

AMENDING A RULE

Relating to filing of property and casualty insurance forms.

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

The purpose of this rule is to clarify the wording in s. Ins 6.05 (4) (a) and (b). Section Ins 6.05 (4) (b) 7. requires the commissioner to establish a schedule designating the calendar month for filing a list of all policy forms. This rule establishes the schedule. This rule implements and interprets s. 631.20, Stats.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Commissioner of
Insurance by section 601.41 (3), Wisconsin Statutes, the Commissioner of
Insurance hereby amends a rule interpreting and implementing s. 631.20,
Wisconsin Statutes, as follows:

SECTION 1.

Ins 6.05 (4) (a) is amended to read:

(a)-From-a-licensed-rate-service-organization---A-Each licensed rate service organization shall file all basic policy forms and endorsements intended for use in Wisconsin for the commissioner's prior approval. Such filing shall be accompanied by a duplicate transmittal letter which sets forth the same information as that required of individual insurers in par. (b). Upon approval, such filings will automatically apply to affiliated insurers.

SECTION 2.

Ins 6.05 (4) (b) (intro.) is amended to read:

(b) From-an-individual-insurer---Each <u>licensed</u> insurer shall file all basic policy forms, standard basic policy forms, endorsements and standard endorsements, as defined in the rule, for the commissioner's prior approval. Each filing shall be accompanied by a duplicate transmittal letter which sets forth the following:

SECTION 3.

Ins 6.05 (4) (b) 7. is amended to read:

7. For information purposes, each insurer shall submit a listing of all basic policy forms and endorsements by form number, title and edition date that it intends to use in Wisconsin and shall update such list, as needed, but in no event less than once per year. Aschedule-shall-be-adopted-by-the-commissioner-which-will-designate-the-calendar-month-for-filing-the-listing-by-the-various-insurers-and/or insurer-groups:--Such filing is required from each individual insurer and filings by "insurer groups" are not permitted. The listing of forms

and endorsements submitted annually will become the permanent record of basic forms and endorsements for each insurer. Annual filings of lists are due during the month shown opposite the first letter of the company name in the following schedule:

SECTION 4.

EFFECTIVE DATE. As provided in s. 227.028 (1), (intro.), this rule shall take effect on the first day of the month following its publication.
