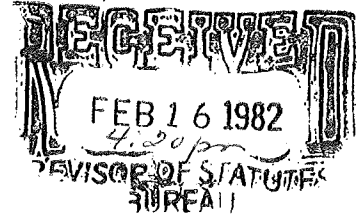



ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES REPEALING RULES

To repeal H 50 relating to joint county homes and tuberculosis sanatoria.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Health and Social Services:

Section 149.02, Stats., gives the Department authority to regulate the establishment and operation of county homes in parts of buildings housing tuberculosis sanatoria. Chapter H 50, Wis. Adm. Code, implemented those authorities.

The Department proposes to repeal ch. H 50, Wis. Adm. Code, because the chapter's provisions are no longer applicable. There are no tuberculosis sanatoria in Wisconsin. Furthermore, there are no county homes. County homes have all been converted to nursing homes and other types of regulated facilities for personal care, health care, and mental health care.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Health and Social Services by s. 140.05(3), Stats., the Department hereby repeals rules interpreting s. 149.02(2), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter H 50 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.


