RENEWAL EXAMINATIONS FOR OPERATOR'S

MVD 20.01 Examination required MVD 20.02 Test of applicant's eyesight

MVD 20.01 Examination required. In accordance with section 343.16 (1) (a) and (2), Wis. Stats., effective July 1, 1969, the division shall examine the eyesight of every applicant for a renewal of an operator's license.

MVD 20.02 Test of applicants eyesight. (1) The following visual acuity requirements apply to applicants for renewal of an operator's license.

- (a) 1. 20/40 or better, each eye or
2. 20/30 or better, one eye, when less than 20/40 in the other eye.

(b) If it is necessary to wear corrective lenses to meet the standard stated in par. (a) 1 or 2, the license will be restricted to require wearing corrective lenses when driving. Persons having 20/100 or less vision in one eye, but with 20/30 or better in the other eye, will be restricted to operation of vehicles with outside mirrors; one on the left and one on the right side of the vehicle, adjusted so as to give a view of traffic to the rear.

(c) Persons unable to meet the above requirements will be required to be examined by an ophthalmologist or optometrist hereafter referred to as a "vision specialist". The following minimum requirements apply when the vision specialist has made a recommendation that a license be issued.

1. 20/60 or better, each eye, or
2. 20/50 or better, one eye when vision is less than 20/60 in the other eye.

The administrator will consider the statement of findings of the vision specialist in applying restrictions to the license.

(d) Persons with visual acuity less than the above standards may be issued a restricted license under certain conditions. In issuing or denying a restricted license the administrator will consider the statement of findings and any recommendations of the vision specialist, the area in which the applicant must operate, the need for a license, whether the operation can be limited to daylight hours, and the applicant's ability to otherwise qualify for a license.

(2) Applicants will be screened for color vision but will not be denied a license or be referred to a vision specialist because of this deficiency only.

(3) A test for visual field will be conducted in those cases when:

(a) The applicant has a physical condition which prevents or restricts him from turning his head or has a paralysis of gaze of the eyes;

(b) The examiner suspects a field defect;

(c) If a review of the individual's driver record shows intersection accidents are repeated. Those persons having a minimum horizontal form field of less than 70° in each eye will be referred to a vision specialist.

(4) Persons who have eye conditions other than described in 20.02 (1) and (2) may be required to be examined by a vision specialist to obtain a report on the condition and secure a recommendation. These other conditions may be, but are not limited to, double vision, "tunnel visions", cataracts, nystagmus, lateral or vertical imbalance. Applicants who have eye conditions which prevent issuance of an unrestricted license may or may not be issued a restricted license; the administrator shall consider the statement of findings and recommendations of the vision specialist, the safety of the motoring public, the need for a license, the area of travel, whether operation can be limited to daylight hours and the applicant's ability to otherwise qualify for a restricted license.

INSTRUCTIONS -- READ CAREFULLY

For any charge: A plea of not guilty may be made by regular mail to the Court. The court will inform you of the trial date.

Failure to appear in court as directed or to post a cash deposit may result in issuance of a warrant for your arrest.

The court may refuse to forfeit a cash deposit and order you to appear in court.

FOR VIOLATION OF TRAFFIC CRIMES: Appearance in court is required for charges under certain statutes. The arresting officer has informed you if this citation charges you with a traffic crime.

FOR VIOLATION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS: If you do not wish to appear in court to answer this citation, you may satisfy this matter without appearing in court by following one of the two following procedures:

- A. Make a STIPULATION AND A DEPOSIT. To do this you must, WITHIN 10 DAYS OF THE VIOLATION, do the following:
 1. Sign the "Statement of Notice" on the back of your citation.
 2. Sign the "Statement of Stipulation" on the back of your citation.
 3. Mail or deliver your copy of this citation, together with the required amount of deposit plus court costs and penalty assessment to the police agency that issued this citation (or to the appropriate Clerk of Court if directed to do so by the issuing officer). Remittance should be made payable to the appropriate Clerk of Court or Municipal Justice as directed by the issuing officer.
- B. Make a DEPOSIT ONLY. (No "Stipulation of No Contest" required.) To do this you must, prior to the court date shown on the citation, mail the required amount of deposit plus court costs and penalty assessment to the Clerk of Court at the Clerk's address. Be advised that if you fail to appear in court at the time fixed on the citation, you will be deemed to have tendered a plea of no contest and submitted to forfeiture plus costs and penalty assessment not to exceed the amount of the deposit which the court may accept as provided in s. 345.37, or if you fail to appear in court at the time fixed on the citation and if the court does not accept the deposit as a forfeiture for the violation, you will be summoned into court to answer the complaint.

If you have deposited your valid Wisconsin operator's license and you fail to either make a stipulation and deposit, or to make a deposit without stipulation, and you do not appear in court on your court date, the court shall order your license suspended for a period of 30 days or until the case is disposed of, whichever is longer.
