ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE DEPARTMENT : REGULATION & LICENSING REPEALING,

OF REGULATION & LICENSING : AMENDING OR ADOPTING RULES

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Regulation and Licensing in 227.014, and 452.07, as affected by ch. 94, Laws of 1981, the Real Estate Examining Board hereby creates, amends and adopts rules, interpreting ss. 452.09, 452.10, and 452.12, as affected by ch. 94, Laws of 1981, as follows:

Section 1. Section REB 2.03 of the Wisconsin administrative code is created to read:

- 2.03 TIME FOR COMPLETING LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS. An applicant for a broker's or salesperson's license who successfully completes both the uniform and state parts of the examination, as provided in this chapter, has one year following the date of examination to complete all other requirements for licensure. No license shall be granted until all requirements are met. If the applicant fails to complete the requirements within the one-year period, he or she shall reapply and successfully complete the examination before a license may be granted.
- Section 2. Section REB 16.02(1) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:
- (1) Each applicant for an original real estate broker's license shall present with-the-application-for-a-license evidence of attendance at 60 hours of an educational program approved by the board in accordance with this chapter.
- Section 3. Section REB 16.02(4)(intro.) and (4)(b) of the Wisconsin administrative code are amended to read:
- (4) (intro.) Subject to the approval of the board, sub. (3) (b) and (e) may be satisfied if:
- The applicant submits evidence of attendance at educational programs offered in another state which are substantially in compliance with the requirements of in sub. (3)(b) or (e).
- Section 4. Section REB 16.03(2)(b) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:
- (b) This requirement may be satisfied as provided in s. REB 16.02(4), except that the educational programs shall be substantially in compliance with requirements in s. REB 16.02(3)(b) or (c).

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Section 5. Section REB 16.05(1) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

(1) To establish an applicant's satisfactory completion of the continuing education requirement, every licensee shall submit to the board a record or evidence of attendance at a minimum of 10 hours of approved educational programs or training sessions credit courses or non-credit educational programs every two years. To qualify under this section, non-credit educational programs and training sessions shall be approved before they are conducted.

Section 6. Section REB 16.05(4)(intro.) of the Wisconsin administrative code is repealed.

Section 7. Section REB 16.076 of the Wisconsin administrative code is created to read:

16.076: Correspondence courses do not satisfy educational requirements in this chapter except to satisfy requirements in s.REB 16.02(2)(a).

The rules created, amended and adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.026, Stats.

The attached order of the Department of Regulation and Licensing (Clearinghouse Rule 81-220) was begun by the Real Estate Examining Board prior to enactment of Chapter 94, Laws of 1981.
