ORDER OF THE
STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION
CREATING AND AMENDING RULES

1 Relating to rules concerning the elimination of issuing life licenses
2 after July 1, 1983, and establishing a continuing professional growth
3 requirement for recertification.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Public Instruction

The proposed amendments to the Administrative Code interpreting ss. 115.01(11), 115.28(7), 115.28(7m) and 118.24(1), Stats., eliminates the issuance of life licenses for all professional school employees after July 1, 1983.

For professional school personnel to remain competent throughout their careers, they must be involved in an ongoing education program. The proposed amendments help to assure the updating of professional knowledge and skills. The renewal requirements and equivalencies are specified in proposed Clearinghouse Rule 81-216 which will become PI 3.03(2)(b).

4 Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Superintendent of Public
5 Instruction by ss. 115.28(7) and 115.28(7m), Stats., interpreting ss. 115.01
6 (11) and 118.24(1), Stats., the State Superintendent hereby amends and
7 creates the administrative rules as follows:

8 SECTION 1. PI 3.03(2)(a) is created to read:

9 PI 3.03(2)(a) Regular license. Effective July 1, 1983, all regular
10 licenses shall be issued for a term of 5 years. Life licenses will not be
11 issued after July 1, 1983. Persons holding life licenses issued prior to
12 July 1, 1983, are not affected by this rule and are subject to the provisions
13 of sub. (3).

14 SECTION 2. PI 3.03(2) through (6) are renumbered PI 3.03(3) through (7).

15 SECTION 3. PI 3.07 subdivisions are amended as follows:

16 PI 3.07(5)(g) Until July 1, 1983, a The life license may be issued to
17 an applicant who has successfully taught the subject in Wisconsin schools for

1 3 years while holding a valid license and has completed an Approved-Program
2 approved program major or a master's degree in the subject. Until July 1,
3 1982, life licenses may be issued to a holder of a minor in elementary music
4 teaching.

5 PI 3.07(7)(a)8c Until July 1, 1983, a The life license may be issued
6 to the school librarian who has completed or possesses:

7 PI 3.07(9)(a)4d4) Until July 1, 1983, a The life license as a school
8 nurse may be issued after 3 years of successful full-time work, or its
9 equivalent, as a licensed school nurse in a Wisconsin school to:

10 PI 3.07(12)(b) Until July 1, 1983, a A life license may be issued to
11 an applicant who has completed all requirements and has completed 3 years of
12 successful experience as a school business manager while fully certified, as
13 verified by the employing official.

15 applicant who has completed or possesses:


