NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That pursuant to authority vested in the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors in ss. 15.08(5), 227.014 and Chapter 443, Stats., the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors hereby amends, creates and adopts rules, interpreting ss. 443.04(1)(c) and 443.09, Stats., as follows:

Section 1. Section A-E 1.15(5)(e) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

(e) Requirements for entrance to examinations. 1- To be eligible to enter take the "Fundamentals of Engineering" section of the examination examination sections on fundamentals of engineering and principles and practice of engineering, an applicant must shall have 4 years of qualifying engineering work experience or a combination of academic credit or engineering work experience which totals 4 years. Applicants who have obtained senior standing in an educational program of study of at least 4 years which leads to a baccalaureate degree in engineering or engineering technology may enter the "Fundamentals of Engineering" section of the examination are eligible to take the examination sections.

2. To be eligible to enter the "Principles and Practice of Engineering" section of the examination, an applicant must have 3 years of qualifying engineering work experience, plus the requirement of the above paragraph.

Section 2. Section A-E 1.175 of the Wisconsin administrative code is created to read:

1.175 EXPERIENCE IN WISCONSIN In addition to other experience requirements in this chapter, an applicant for registration as a professional engineer under s. 443.04(1)(c), Stats., shall submit evidence that the applicant has had at least 6 months of engineering experience in Wisconsin or has had sufficient contacts with this state to make the applicant familiar with Wisconsin engineering law and practice.

The rules contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 226.026, Stats.
