IN THE MATTER OF RULEMAKING : ORDER OF THE VETERINARY PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE : EXAMINING BOARD REPEALING, VETERINARY EXAMINING BOARD : AMENDING OR ADOPTING RULES

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to authority vested in the Veterinary Examining Board in ss. 15.08(5), 227.014, and Chapter 453, Stats., the Veterinary Examining Board hereby amends and adopts rules, interpreting s. 453.06, Stats., as follows:

- Section 1. Section VE 2.08(1)(intro.) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:
- VE 2.08(1)(intro.) A graduate of a veterinary college approved by the board who meets all requirements for examination may be granted a temporary permit to practice veterinary medicine until the results of the next examination are known provided the applicant is employed and supervised by a lieensed veterinarian licensed in Wisconsin. Applicants for such a temporary permit must shall provide prior to appearance before the board:
- Section 2. Section VE 2.08(1)(a) and (b) of the Wisconsin administrative code are renumbered to read 2.08(1)(b) and (c) respectively.
- Section 3. Section VE 2.08(1)(a) of the Wisconsin administrative code is created to read:
 - VE 2.08(1)(a) A completed application form approved by the board.
- Section 4. Section VE 2.08(2) of the Wisconsin administrative code is repealed.
- Section 5. Section VE 2.08(3) of the Wisconsin administrative code is renumbered to (2).
- Section 6. Section VE 2.09 of the Wisconsin administrative code is repealed and recreated to read:
- (1) The examination for a veterinary VE 2.09 EXAMINATION FOR LICENSE. license consists of a written examination and a principles of practice examination.
- (2) The score required to pass the examination shall be based on the board's determination of the level of examination performance required for minimum acceptable competence in the profession and on the reliability of the examination. The passing score shall be established prior to giving the examination and shall be designated by a grade of 70.

The rules contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin adminstrative register, pursuant to s. 227.026, Wis. Stats.
