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ORDER OF THE

AMENDING RULES

1 To amend PI 14.01 relating to school district membership counts:

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Public Instruction

The proposed membership rule restates the DPI rule relating to school district membership counts to provide applicability to the additional count date required by Chapter 20, Laws of 1981 (s. 121.05(1)(a)(intro.), Stats.).

2 Pursuant to the authority vested in the Department of Public Instruc-
3 tion by s. 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the Department hereby amends rules inter-
4 preting s. 121.05(1)(a), Stats., as follows:

5 SECTION 1. PI 14.01 is amended to read:

6 PI 14.01 OFFICIAL ENROLLMENT. (1) A resident pupil may be included
7 in the official enrollments of the schools of a district as of the date dates
8 specified in s. 121.05(1)(a), Stats., only if:

9 (a) ~~He-er-she~~ The pupil is in attendance on ~~that-date~~ the date specified;

10 or

11 (b) ~~He-er-she~~ The pupil is absent on ~~that-date~~ the date specified but
12 has attended at least one day during the current school year prior to ~~that~~
13 date the date specified and attends at least one day after ~~that-date~~ the date
14 specified and remained a resident of the district during the period of
15 absence; or


16 (c) In the event a pupil has been absent all days during the ~~current~~
17 school year prior to and on ~~that-date~~ the date specified, an application has
18 been made for formal homebound instruction as of ~~that-date~~ the date specified
19 and documentation exists to support this application.

20 (2) If a pupil who is eligible to be included in the official enrollment

1 under sub. (1)(b) of this section returns following the filing of the fall
2 budget specified membership report, an amended report shall be filed.

The amendment of PI 14.01 shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register as provided in s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats.
