



RULES in FINAL DRAFT FORM

Rule: W.A.C. Chapter Ind 3

Relating to: Mines, Pits and Quarries

Administrative rules to repeal Ind 3.18 (14); and to create Ind 3.015 and Ind 3.02 (34a).

ANALYSIS OF RULES

The Division of Safety and Buildings of the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations is responsible for the enforcement of the Mines, Pits and Quarries Code, Chapter Ind 3, Wisconsin Administrative Code. The proposed rules will require advance notification to the department of the intent to begin work in a pit or quarry. The notification is to include the location of the pit or quarry and the party responsible for the work. This information will aid the department in carrying out the inspection activities specified in Ind 3.01, Wisconsin Administrative Code.

The proposed rules will also require notification to the local sheriff and emergency medical arrangements in the event of an accident. This requirement is presently specified in s. Ind 3.18 (14), Wisconsin Administrative Code.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the state of Wisconsin, Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by s. 101.02 (1) and s. 101.02 (15) (h) through (j), Stats., the department hereby creates and repeals rules interpreting s. 101.02 (15) (h) through (j) and s. 101.15, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. Ind 3.015 is created to read:

Ind 3.015 NOTIFICATION TO BEGIN OPERATION. (1) Each year before work is commenced in a pit or quarry, the pit or quarry operator shall complete and return to the department form SBD 6736, Notice to Begin Operation, for each pit or quarry. The notification shall be received by the department at least 10 days prior to the beginning of work in each pit or quarry.

Note #1: The notice is required from the operator for all pits and quarries where work is performed, whether or not the operator owns the pit or quarry.

Note #2: Copies of form SBD 6736 are available from the Division of Safety and Buildings, P.O. Box 7969, Madison, Wisconsin 53707.

(2) Each year before work is commenced in a pit or quarry, the pit or quarry operator shall notify the local sheriff and make arrangements for obtaining emergency medical assistance and transportation for injured persons.

SECTION 2. Ind 3.02 (34a) is created to read:

Ind 3.02 (34a) "Operator" means the person or firm that owns or is responsible for the crushing, screening or washing equipment.

SECTION 3. Ind 3.18 (14) is repealed.
