Administrative rule to repeal s. Ind 95.16 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code relating to the trade specialist rule in apprenticeship programs

Plain language analysis by
the department of industry, labor and human relations

This rule repeals the trade specialist rule recently adopted by the department which permits the department to certify a person as a trade specialist as opposed to a full apprentice. The department received a petition for repeal of the rule pursuant to s. 227.015, Stats.
