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

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PROPOSED ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

Amending a Rule

To amend section Ins 17.28 (6) (h) and (i) relating to fees for nurse anesthetists and podiatrists participating in the Patients Compensation Fund.

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

This (rule) implements and interprets s. 655.27 (3), Stats.

On March 10, 1982, the Board of Governors of the Patients Compensation Fund passed a resolution creating a fee relativity schedule applying to several classes of health care providers. Application of this relativity fee schedule in Ins 17.28 (6) (h) and (i) resulted in fee increases for podiatrists and nurse anesthetists of a magnitude which was not intended by the Board. The purpose of this amendment is to provide equitable fees for nurse anesthetists and podiatrists in accordance with the intent of the Board.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Commissioner of Insurance by section 655.27 (3), Stats, the Commissioner of Insurance

hereby proposes to amend a rule implementing and interpreting
section 655.27 (3), Stats, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section Ins 17.28 (6) (h) and (i) is amended to read:

(h) For nurse anesthetists	\$--114:00	\$ 73.00
(i) For podiatrists (non surgical)	373:00	220.00
For podiatrists (surgical)	1,490:00	878.00
For retired or part time podiatrists, non surgical office practice only, less than 500 hours practice per annum	224:00	132.00

The amendment of section Ins 17.28 (6) (h) and (i) shall take
effect as provided in s. 227.026 (1) (intro.), Stats.
