ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYE TRUST FUNDS
REPEALING RULES

To repeal s. ETF 6.01 relating to the payment of additional deposits or contributions as a monthly annuity certain.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Employee Trust Funds

This rule contains provisions for electing a monthly annuity certain, from voluntary additional contributions or deposits, in lieu of the optional forms of annuity available. These provisions are now covered by statute making the rule unnecessary.

This rule relates to s. 40.24 (5), Stats., as created by Ch. 96, Laws of 1981.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Employee Trust Funds by s. 40.03

(2) (i), Stats., as created by Ch. 96, Laws of 1981, the Department of Employee Trust Funds repeals a rule related to s. 40.24 (5), Stats., as created by Ch. 96, Laws of 1981, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section ETF 6.01 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

The repeal contained in this order shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026 (1) (intro.), Stats.
