#### ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

#### REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing and recreating s.

NR 20.10(4)(b) of the Wisconsin Administrative

Code pertaining to permits to take bait in

trout streams

F-57-81

### Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Bait dealers currently cannot use seines or dip nets in trout waters at any time, nor minnow traps in trout waters during the closed trout season. In some Class II and III trout streams, bait fish are abundant and adversely compete with trout for the food resource affecting trout growth and survival. This rule will grant the Department authority to issue bait permits in such waters. It is anticipated this will benefit bait dealers, please anglers and enhance the trout fishery.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.174, 227.014 and 227.02(1)(e), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals and recreates rules interpreting s. 29.174, Stats., as follows:

#### SECTION 1 - NR 20.10 (4) (b) is repealed and recreated to read:

(b) Unless a permit has been issued by the department, no person may use minnow seines or minnow dip nets of any type or description in inland streams or tributary spring holes inhabited by trout. Licensed bait dealers may use no more than a total of 20 minnow traps when removing minnows from one or more trout streams during the open season for trout, unless a permit has been issued. Persons not possessing a bait dealers license may use no more than a total of 3 minnow traps when conducting such removal. During the closed trout season, minnows may not be removed except by licensed bait dealers as authorized by permit.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on March 25, 1982.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026 (1)(intro.), Stats.
