Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

The amendment to s. NR 25.06(2)(a), Wis. Adm. Code, changes the total allowable annual harvest of chubs in Lake Michigan and Northern Green Bay. Specifically, it increases it from 1,500,000 pounds to 1,650,000 pounds.

The amendment to s. NR 25.07(2)(a)1.b.1), Wis. Adm. Code, changes the annual allowable harvest of chubs in the southern chub fishing area. Specifically, the annual allowable harvest of chubs in the southern chub fishing area is increased from 1,200,000 pounds to 1,350,000 pounds, with a 450,000 pound maximum for each of three 3-month fishing periods within the open season.

The amendment to s. NR 25.07(2)(a)1.c., Wis. Adm. Code, clarifies the fact that weekly reports are to be filed by each permit holder throughout the open season, regardless of whether they fished or not. This is necessary to maintain accurate records of fishing activity.

The amendment to s. NR 25.07(3), Wis. Adm. Code, deletes procedures for filing applications for individual license year catch quotas during 1978-79 and 1979-80 license years.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.085, 29.174, 29.33 and 227.014, Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules interpreting s. 29.33, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 25.06(2)(a) is amended to read:

(a) The total allowable annual harvest of chubs in Wisconsin waters of Lake Michigan and northern Green Bay shall ~~shall~~ may not exceed ~~1,500,000~~ 1,650,000

pounds, not to include incidental catches allowed elsewhere in this chapter. No more than 200,000 pounds of the total may be taken in those waters of Lake Michigan north of a line extending due east from the red navigational buoy marking the entrance of Baileys Harbor, this portion to be taken only during the period from July 1 through December 31.

SECTION 2. NR 25.07(2)(a)1.b.1) is amended to read:

1) In those waters commonly referred to as the southern chub fishing area, no more than ~~400,000~~ 450,000 pounds of chubs may be harvested during each of the 3 month periods encompassed by the months of July, August and September, the months of October, November and December, and the months of April, May and June respectively.

SECTION 3. NR 25.07(2)(a)1.c. is amended to read:

c. Each permit holder shall submit weekly reports on forms provided by the department. The weekly reports shall be mailed to the department at the address provided on the forms and shall be postmarked no later than the following Monday following the weekly report period during the open season. Weekly reports shall be filed by each permit holder regardless of whether the permit holder fished or not.

SECTION 4. NR 25.07(3) is amended to read:

(3) Applications for individual license year catch quotas shall be made on forms provided by the department and filed with it as designated on those forms no later than March 15 preceding the license year for which a quota is requested. ~~except applications for the remainder of the 1978-1979 license year and the 1979-80 license year for Lake Michigan individual~~

~~quotas shall be filed in a manner as directed by the Lake Michigan commercial fishing board by certified letter to all commercial fishers on Lake Michigan licensed under s. 29.33, Stats.~~

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on May 26, 1982.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats.
