CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 82-117

Analysis by the Department of Transportation

Prior to 1977, rental companies were regulated by the Public Service Commission. Chapter 29, Laws of 1977, transferred this responsibility to the Department of Transportation. This rule renumbers the rules applicable to rental companies from the PSC series to the TRANS series. The rule also substitutes the words department of transportation for public service commission wherever applicable. No substantive change is being made in the rule.

Fiscal Estimate

No fiscal effect is anticipated from the promulgation of these rule changes.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Transportation by s. 194.44, the Department adopts rules interpreting s. 194.44, Stats., as follows:

Text of Rule

SECTION 1. PSC 65 is renumbered TRANS 175.

SECTION 2. TRANS 175.03, as renumbered, is amended to

read:

TRANS 175.03 REGISTRATION. Each rental company, before engaging in such business, shall file an application with the public-service-commission department of transportation on forms prescribed by it and secure an identifying registration number. Said registration number will be issued after such investigation as the commission department may deem necessary, either with or without hearing. The commission, department, after giving applicant opportunity to be heard, may attach to such rental company registration such conditions as may be deemed necessary to accomplish the purpose of section 194.44(2), Wis. Stats.

SECTION 3. TRANS 175.04(2) and (4)(d), as renumbered, are amended to read:

TRANS 175.04(2) Have title in its name for all motor vehicles used in the rental business or furnish evidence to the Wisconsin department of transportation,-division-of-motor-vehicles, that a bona fide agreement between the rental company and a licensed dealer or manufacturer has been executed and includes an option to purchase such motor vehicles.

(4) (d) Be completed on forms which are serially numbered, and a sample copy of which form has previously been filed with the public-service-commission-of-Wisconsin department of transportation.

SECTION 4. TRANS 175.06, as renumbered, is amended to read:

TRANS 175.06 CONTRACT AND COMMON MOTOR CARRIERS. No person holding a Wisconsin intrastate contract motor carrier license or common motor carrier of property or of passengers certificate shall be granted a rental company registration except as otherwise authorized by the commission department of transportation upon application and for good cause shown.

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SECTION 5. TRANS 175.07(1), as renumbered, is amended to read:

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TRANS 175.07(1) The public-service-commission-of-Wisconsin and Wisconsin department of transportation, division-of-motor vehicles, or their its duly authorized agents shall, during normal business hours have access and authority to inspect, examine, and copy any and all accounts, books, records, memorandums, correspondence, and other documents pertaining to the rental company business. These records shall be made available at the company's place of business in Wisconsin within a reasonable time upon request of the public-service commission-of-Wisconsin-or-Wisconsin department of transportation,-division-of-meter-vehicles.

SECTION 6. TRANS 175.09, as renumbered, is amended to read:

TRANS 175.09 SERVICE REQUIREMENTS. Every rental company registration issued by the public-service-commission-of-Wisconsin department of transportation shall be conditional upon the establishment of service thereunder within a reasonable time and maintenance thereof with reasonable continuity. Failure to maintain vehicles properly qualified for rental for a period of more than 1 year is a violation of this section unless permission is secured from the commission department to discontinue service for a longer period upon good cause shown.
