Analysis Prepared by the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection

The proposed changes in the rules concerning dairy cattle grade requirements are made for purposes of clarifying the scope and intent of the rule, deleting obsolete or no longer used provisions, and updating the grade requirements to conform with current dairy herd improvement grades. A major change is elimination of the requirement for a heifer or cow to have a registered sire to be graded Wisconsin Superior and Wisconsin Preferred D.H.I. With artifical insemination so widely used in raising replacement cattle, it is uncommon for the animal owner to have records showing the registration number of the sire for heifers, which comprise a majority of the sales. Wisconsin's dairy industry would be unable to have cattle qualify for these two grades if this requirement is The possibility of falsified information being not changed. placed on the official certificate is also reduced by elimination of this requirement.

A second change is a major revision in the table of weights in s. Ag 93.05(a) for graded heifers. Minimum weight requirements are specified for heifers in the 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th months of pregnancy as well as for the 7th and 8th months of pregnancy included in the existing table. In today's market, export buyers desire to purchase animals as soon as pregnancy can be detected. The table is therefore expanded to specify weights from 3 to 9 months of pregnancy.
