ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The following changes are being made to the 1983 trapping regulations to minimize accidental trapping of eagles, hawks and owls:

1. Sight exposed bait used for trapping is defined.
2. Sight exposed bait composed of animal flesh, fur, hide or entrails may not exceed one inch on any one side. Feathers may not be used for trapping purposes.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by s. 29.174(1), 227.014(2)(a) and 227.022(3), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends and creates rules interpreting s. 29.174(1), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 10.001(24) is created to read:

(24) "Sight exposed bait" means any bait which can be seen from above the bait.

SECTION 2. NR 10.13(1)(b)2. is amended to read:

2. Bait or scent. Set out or place bait or scent for attracting furbearing animals during the closed season. During the open season, no person may use sight exposed bait consisting of:

a. Feathers.

b. Animal flesh, fur, hide, or entrails exceeding, in aggregate, one inch on any one side.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on March 23, 1983.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1) (intro.), Stats.
