PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE : EXAMINING BOARD REPEALING,
PSYCHOLOGY EXAMINING BOARD : AMENDING OR ADOPTING RULES

ORDER

Pursuant to authority vested in the Psychology Examining Board in ss. 15.08(5), 227.014, 227.02(1)(b) and 455.08, Stats., the Psychology Examining Board hereby amends and adopts rules, interpreting ss. 455.04(1)(b), 455.05 and 455.08, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. Psy 3.02(intro.) is amended to read:

Psy 3.02 PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT. The practice of psychology is complex and varied, and therefore allows for a broad range of professional conduct. The following acts constitute unprofessional conduct by applicants for licensure and licensees of the board and are prohibited. Complaints regarding these acts will shall be investigated and may lead to disciplinary proceedings. ~~These acts shall be considered exclusively as evidence of lack of "good-moral-character" in reviewing applications for licensure.~~

The rule amendment and adoption in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.026, Stats.
