## ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

## Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Section NR 212.60, Wis. Adm. Code, assigns wasteload allocations to municipalities on the Upper Wisconsin River from Brokaw to Lake Du Bay. Based on new information, the wasteload allocations have become outdated. In order to approve the proposed regional wastewater treatment facility at Rothschild as a secondary treatment plant, additional pounds of BOD must be reallocated from industrial dischargers. Based on engineering review by Department staff, a daily maximum BOD discharge level based on the design flow of the treatment plant and an appropriate concentration is required as a condition of approval of the facility plan.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by 144.025(2)(b), 147.04(5) and 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals and recreates rules interpreting s. 147.04(5), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 212.60(1)(c) is repealed and recreated to read:

(c) The baseline load for each publicly-owned point source located between milepoints 235.4 and 271.1 shall be calculated as follows:

Baseline Load = (Q)(8.34)(C)

Where Q = 0.55 million gallons per day for publicly-owned point sources located between milepoints 235.4 and 250.0.

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2. The allocation for publicly-owned point sources located between milepoint 250.0 and 260.0 shall be determined as follows:

a. For the period January 1, 1986 through December 31, 1990, the allocation shall be determined as follows:

Point Source Allocation = (Q)(8.34)(45)

Where Q = 3.1 million gallons per day

8.34 = Conversion factor

45 = 45 milligrams per liter concentration of  $BOD_{5}$ 

- b. For each 5-year period beginning January 1, 1991 through December 31, 2005, the allocation shall be redetermined on the basis of projected flows and the demonstrated treatment capability of the point source. The redetermination shall be made at the time of each 5-year reevaluation under NR 212.06(2). No allocation may exceed the baseline load as determined in sub. (1)(c).
- 3. The allocation for publicly-owned point sources located between milepoints 260.0 and 265.0 shall be its baseline load as determined in sub.

  (1)(c) for the period ending December 31, 1985. The allocation to become effective on January 1, 1986 shall be determined at the time of the first 5-year reevaluation under NR 212.06(2).
- 4. The allocation for publicly-owned point sources located between milepoints 265.0 and 271.1 shall be its baseline load as determined under sub. (1)(c).

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on July 27, 1983.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026 (1)(intro.), Stats..
