PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS, : SURVEYORS REPEALING, AMENDING  
DESIGNERS AND LAND SURVEYORS : OR ADOPTING RULES  
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ORDER

Pursuant to authority vested in the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors in ss. 15.08(5)(b), 227.014 and ch. 443, Stats., the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors hereby amend and adopt rules, interpreting s. 443.01(8), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. A-E 5.02(3)(c) is amended to read:

A-E 5.02(3)(c) Reference ties to at least 4 witness monuments, or, if the location is within a municipality, then at least 2 witness monuments. Witness monuments shall be ~~made of~~ concrete, natural stone, iron, bearing trees or other equally durable material, except wood other than bearing trees.

The rule amended and adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.026, Stats.
