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ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION AMENDING RULES

Revisor of Statutes Bureau

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To repeal Adm 30.06(3)(b); to renumber and amend Adm 30.06 (3)(a); to amend Adm 30.13(5); to create Adm 30.085, relating to payroll deductions for charitable purposes.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Administration:

Section Adm 30.06(3)(b) is repealed to delete obsolete material from the rule.

Section Adm 30.06(3)(a) is renumbered and amended to remove the reference to Adm 30.06(3)(b) which is repealed in this order.

Section Adm 30.085 is created to allow the eligibility committee to review late applications from charitable organizations for good cause shown.

Section Adm 30.13(5) is amended to extend the time that the Secretary shall notify umbrella organizations in writing of the acceptance or rejection for payroll deduction.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Department of Administration by ss. 20.921(1)(a) 4 and 16.004(1), Stats., the Department of Administration amends rules interpreting s. 20.921(1)(a) 4, Stats., as follows:

- SECTION 1. Adm 30.06(3)(a) is renumbered Adm 30.06(3) and amended to read:
- (3) TIME OF FILING. (a)--Except-as-provided-in-par:-(b); applications Must be received on or before February l of any year in order for a charitable organization to be considered for eligibility for payroll deduction during the following year.

SECTION 2. Adm 30.06(3)(b) is repealed.

SECTION 3. Adm 30.085 is created to read:

Adm 30.085 ELIGIBILITY COMMITTEE. The eligibility committee may waive the requirements of Adm 30.06(3) for good cause shown and if the review of the late application or part of the application can be completed by the eligibility committee before the final format for the printed materials is established for use in the State Employes Combined Campaign which is held in October and November of each year.

SECTION 4. Adm 30.13(5) is amended to read:

(5) The secretary shall, by Mareh-16 May 1 of each year, notify the umbrella organization in writing of the acceptance or rejection for payroll deduction of each charitable organization.

The rule amendments contained in this order shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats.
