IN THE MATTER OF THE AMENDMENT ) OF CHAPTER TRANS 176, WISCONSIN ) ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, RELATING ORDER ) TO FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY ) ADOPTING REQUIREMENTS FOR "FOR-HIRE" RULE PROPERTY CARRIERS UTILIZING VEHICLES OF 10,000 POUNDS AND LESS GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT )

### Analysis Prepared by DOT-OGC

General summary of rule. Section 194.41(6)(b) of the statutes sets the minimum liability limits for "for-hire" property carriers utilizing vehicles of 10,000 pounds or less at \$300,000. The Department's current rule provides that carriers utilizing vehicles of less than 10,000 pounds are subject to the \$300,000 limit. This rule amends TRANS 176.06(1)(a)3 and 4 so that the correct weight category is stated in the rule in compliance with the statute.

## Fiscal Estimate

This rule will have no fiscal impact independent of the fiscal effect of the law. The Department does not anticipate that promulgation of this rule will have any fiscal impact on its operations.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the DOT by ss. 194.41 and 227.014, Stats., the Department of Transportation hereby amends rules interpreting ss. 194.41(6), Stats., as follows:

#### RULE TEXT

SECTION 1. Chapter TRANS 176.06(1)(a)3 and 4 are amended to

read:

TRANS 176.06(1)(a)3.

Vehicles of under 10,000 \$300,000 \$300,000 pounds or less gross weight transporting non-hazardous substances TRANS 176.06(1)(a)4

Vehicles of <u>over</u> 10,000 pounds \$500,000 \$750,000 <del>or-more</del> gross vehicle weight transporting non-hazardous substances

(End of Rule)
