

ORDER

Pursuant to authority vested in the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors in ss. 15.08(5)(b), 227.014 and ch. 443, Stats., the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors hereby repeals, amends, repeals and recreates, creates and adopts rules, interpreting ss. 15.08(5)(b), 443.03(1), 443.04, 443.05(2), 443.06(2), 443.07(1) and 443.09, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. A-E 1.01(2) is amended to read:

A-E 1.01(2) The engineers' section approves, in general, all curricula in engineering that are accredited by the ~~engineers' council for professional development accreditation board for engineering and technology~~ (ABET).

SECTION 2. A-E 1.10 is created to read:

A-E 1.10 EXPERIENCE CREDIT LIMIT. An applicant for registration as an architect, professional engineer, designer or land surveyor may not receive more than one year of satisfactory experience credit during any one calendar year.

SECTION 3. A-E 1.16(2) is amended to read:

A-E 1.16(2) TABLE OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE EQUIVALENTS.

SECTION 4. A-E 3.10 is created to read:

A-E 3.10 RULES COMMITTEE. (1) COMPOSITION. The rules committee of the examining board of architects, professional engineers, designers and land surveyors shall be comprised of one member from each section and one public member from one of the 4 sections appointed by the chairperson of the board.

(2) AUTHORITY AND RESPONSIBILITY. The rules committee shall act for the board in rulemaking proceedings except for final approval and adoption of administrative rules.

The rules repealed, amended, repealed and recreated, created and adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.026, Stats.
