#### CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 83-163

### Analysis Prepared by the Department of Transportation

General summary of rule. Prior to the enactment of Chapter 138, Laws of 1981, a slow moving vehicle emblem of reduced size was required by TRANS 303.06(1)(g) to be mounted on a special vehicle. Chapter 138, Laws of 1981, requires that the slow moving vehicle emblem mounted on a special vehicle be of the same size and dimensions as used on any other vehicle. This rule is being amended to comply with the new statutory provision.

Fiscal Estimate. No fiscal effect is anticipated from the promulgation of this rule change.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the DOT by s. 347.02(6), Stats., the Department of Transportation hereby amends rules interpreting s. 347.02(6), Stats., as follows:

#### RULE TEXT

SECTION 1. Chapter TRANS 303.06(1)(g) is amended to read:

Trans 303.06(1)(g) <u>Slow moving vehicle emblem</u>. The emblem shall be mounted with the point up with the lower edge of the emblem no more than 54 inches nor less than 10 inches above the ground. <u>The</u> A slow moving vehicle emblem <u>shall meet meeting</u> the requirements of s. MVD-22.03 Trans <u>304.047-Wis.-Admin.-Code7-or-of</u> a-reduced-size-shall-be-used.--However7-there shall be-a-minimum distance-of-6-inches-between-the-lower-edge-and-the-upper-point with-corresponding-reduction-in-width-for-symmetrical-appearance. Motor-bicycles-registered-as-specially-designed-vehicles-may,-but need-not,-comply-with-this-requirement.
