ORDER

Pursuant to authority vested in the Hearing Aid Dealers and Fitters Examining Board in ss. 15.08(5), 227.014 and 459.12(1), Stats., the Hearing Aid Dealers and Fitters Examining Board hereby repeals and recreates and adopts rules, interpreting s. 459.06, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. HAD 3.06 is repealed and recreated to read:

HAD 3.06 SCORING. A minimum score of 70 is required on each of the three parts of the examination in order to successfully complete the examination. If an applicant receives a score lower than 70 on one part, he or she may take only the part failed. If an applicant receives a score lower than 70 on more than one part, upon reapplication he or she shall be required to take the entire 3-part examination.

The rule repealed and recreated and adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.026, Stats.
