Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Modifications of three existing administrative rules (s. NR 1.95 and chs. NR 104 and NR 180) are proposed to incorporate the statutory definition of "wetland," found in s. 23.32(1), Stats., in place of administrative code definitions which are inconsistent with it. In addition, language is proposed to be added to the Natural Resources Board policy on Wetland Preservation, Protection, and Management, clarifying the Board's intent that the statutory definition be applied by the Department where a rule uses the term "wetland" and does not contain a specific definition.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by s. 227.014(2)(a), and chs. 30, 144 and 147, Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends and creates rules interpreting chs. 30, 144 and 147, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 1.95(4)(c) is amended to read:

NR 1.95(4)(c) Wetlands-are-those-areas-characterized-by-surface-water-or-saturated-seils-during-at-least-a-part-of-the-growing-season-such-that-moist seil-vegetation-or-shallow-water-plants-can-thrive;—The-permanent-channels-of streams-and-rivers-and-the-open-water-areas-of-lakes-and-reservoirs-are-not included-in-this-definition; "Wetland" as defined in s. 23.32(1), Stats., means an area where water is at, near, or above the land surface long enough to be capable of supporting aquatic or hydrophytic vegetation and which has soils indicative of wet conditions.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1)
(intro.), Stats.
