ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
AMENDING RULES

.....
IN THE MATTER of amending s. NR 30.01(1)(h) .
of the Wisconsin Administrative Code .
pertaining to the establishment of an . Fo-47-83
intensive fire protection zone in the .
Town of Cleveland, Jackson County .

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

On April 6, 1982, the Town of Cleveland, Jackson County, petitioned the Department to extend intensive forest fire protection to the Town of Cleveland in township 24 north, range 5 west. The Town of Cleveland contains 23,040 acres, of which 50% is woodland. At the present time, the Town contracts for fire protection with the Village of Fairchild Fire Department.

The proposed rule will extend intensive forest fire protection to the Town of Cleveland, Jackson County by DNR personnel and equipment. The Town borders the Black River Falls fire control area on its east and north boundaries. The north boundary is one mile from the Fairchild ranger station.

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 26.11, 26.12 and 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends a rule interpreting s. 26.12, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 30.01(1)(h) amended to read:

NR 30.01(1)(h) Jackson county. All lands in: township 20 north, ranges 1 east, 1, 2, 3 and 4 west; township 21 north, ranges 1 east, 1, 2, 3 and 4 west; township 21 north, range 5 west except ~~the following~~ section 18 - S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$; section 19 - NW $\frac{1}{4}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$; and SWSW $\frac{1}{2}$; section 30 - W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$; section 32 - S $\frac{1}{2}$; township 22 north, ranges 1 east, 1, 2, 3 and 4 west; township 23 north, range 4 west; and township 24 north, range 5 west.

The foregoing rule was approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on March 28, 1984.

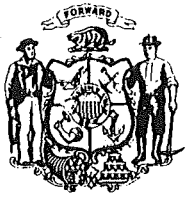
The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1) (intro.), Stats.


