An order to repeal ch. Ind 18, relating to renewable energy financial incentive.

#### ANALYSIS OF PROPOSED RULES

The Division of Safety and Buildings within the department has been responsible under section 101.57, Stats., for the administration and enforcement of the renewable energy resource system incentive program. Sections 20.445 (1) (e), 71.04 (16) (a) and (d) and 101.57, Stats., and sections 2025 (3), 2033 (3m), 2201 (1) (j) and 2202 (1) (d), (5) (b), (25) (a), (45) (n), and (57) (e) of 1983 Wisconsin Act 27 contained provisions to transfer responsibilities for this program to the Department of Administration, effective January 1, 1984. The proposed rules contain the repeal of chapter Ind 18 because the chapter will no longer be enforced by the department. The Department of Administration has promulgated a new set of rules, which become effective on February 1, 1984, for administration of the program.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the state of Wisconsin, Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations, by s. 101.02 (1), 20.445 (1) (e), 71.04 (16) (a) and (d) and 101.57, Stats., and sections 2025 (3), 2033 (3m), 2201 (1) (j), and 2202 (1) (d), (5) (b), (25) (a), (45) (n) and (57) (e) of 1983 Wisconsin Act 27, the department hereby repeals rules interpreting sections 2025 (3), 2033 (3m), 2201 (1) (j) and 2202 (1) (d), (5) (b), (25) (a), (4) (n) and (57) (e) of 1983 Wisconsin Act 27 and s. 101.02 (1), 20.445 (1) (e), 71.04 (16) (a) and (d) and 101.57, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. Ch. Ind 18 is repealed.
