PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE : EXAMINING BOARD REPEALING,
VETERINARY EXAMINING BOARD : AMENDING OR ADOPTING RULES

ORDER

Pursuant to authority vested in the Veterinary Examining Board in ss. 15.08(5)(b), 227.014(20)(a) and ch. 453, Stats., the Veterinary Examining Board hereby rennumbers, amends and adopts rules, interpreting s. 453.07, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. VE 3.02(21) is amended to read:

VE 3.20(21) Failure to keep records as a dispenser of controlled substances as required by s. 161.31, Stats., and s. Phar ~~6.02, Wis. Adm. Code~~ 8.02.

SECTION 2. VE 3.02(22) is renumbered VE 3.02(23) and amended to read:

VE 3.02(23) Failure to ~~keep animal patient records~~ maintain and keep for at least 3 years individual client records for herd or food animal patients and individual patient records for companion animal patients which specify adequately the diagnosis made and, treatment provided on animal and the name of the veterinarian who provided care.

SECTION 3. VE 3.02(22) is created to read:

VE 3.02(22) Failure to include on the label of a prescription drug the generic or brand name of the drug dispensed, the name and address of the clinic or veterinarian dispensing the drug, the directions for use and caution statements required by law.

The rules renumbered, amended and adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.026, Stats.
