ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING, RENUMBERING, AMENDING, REPEALING AND RECREATING, AND CREATING, RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing ss. NR 45.12(1)(e) and 45.13(18)(b)1.e.; renumbering ss. NR 10.24(6)(c) and 45.13(18)(b)2.d.4)f; renumbering and amending s. NR 45.13(18)(b)2.d.4)e; amending ss. NR 10.24 (3)(g), (4)(a), (d), (e) & (f), 15.022 (intro.), and 45.13(18)(b)2.d.3)a, 4)(intro.) & a; repealing and recreating ss. NR 10.24(3)(c), (4)(g), (6)(a) & (b) and 45.12(4)(f) 1. & 2.; and creating ss. NR 10.24(6)(c) & (d) and 45.12(1)(f)5. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to regulations for the use of the Bong state recreation area.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Chapters NR 10, 15 and 45, Wis. Adm. Code, are being revised to improve the quality of the managed hunt and to facilitate the management of the special use zone in the Bong state recreation area. The significant changes incorporated into the rule are:

1. Establishes hunting hours (except deer and waterfowl hours) of 8 a.m. CST to 2 p.m. daily for the first 14 days of pheasant season. Thereafter it reverts to the normal hunting hours.

2. Reduces to 300 the number of daily hunting permits that may be issued prior to 10:00 a.m.

3. Establishes an administrative fee of \$3.00 for pheasant hunting and \$1 for other types of hunting.

4. Allows trapping in the wildlife refuge by permit.

5. Eliminates the per person admission fee for the Special Use Zone and establishes a \$25.00 group reservation fee for the zone.

6. Includes dog trials in the category with waterfowl hunting in the Special Use Zone calendar.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 23.09(13), 23.091(3), 23.11(1), 27.01(2) and (2r), 29.174(1) and 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals, renumbers, amends, repeals and recreates, and creates rules interpreting ss. 23.091(3) and 29.174(1), Stats., as follows: SECTION 1. NR 10.24(3)(c) is repealed and recreated to read:

NR 10.24(3)(c) Daily hunting permits shall be issued as follows:

1. During the first 14 days of the pheasant season, the number of daily hunting permits issued to individuals may not exceed 300.

2. Beginning with the 15th day of the pheasant season, the number of daily hunting permits issued to individuals may not exceed 300 until 10:00 a.m. After 10:00 a.m., additional hunting permits may be issued on a first-come, first-served basis. Beginning in 1986, this subdivision shall apply during the entire pheasant season.

3. During the pheasant season, a maximum of 250 permits may be reserved for pheasant hunting.

SECTION 2. NR 10.24(3)(g) is amended to read:

NR 10.24(3)(g) Permits,-waterfowl-blind-markers, and unused carcass tags shall be returned to a department check-out station immediately upon termination of hunting.

SECTION 3. NR 10.24(4)(a), (d), (e), and (f) are amended to read:

NR 10.24(4)(a) Hunting and trapping permit reservations may be obtained by applying on department forms between April <u>August</u> 1 and August 31 each year.

(d) Applications received after August 31 shall be approved on a first-come, first-served basis if permits are available. <u>Applications may be</u> made in person, by mail or by telephone a minimum of 2 days prior to the desired hunting date.

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(e) No person may receive more than 5 <u>waterfowl</u> and 5 pheasant hunting reservations per season.

(f) Any person who obtains a hunting permit reservation and fails to arrive at the department's check-in station within one-half hour after the opening of hunting hours shall forfeit such reservation-and-reservation-fee. Such Any person with a waterfowl hunting permit reservation shall report at the department's check-in station no later than one-half hour before the opening of hunting hours or forfeit the reservation. Any person may obtain a daily permit on a first-come, first-served basis provided a permit is available.

SECTION 4. NR 10.24(4)(g) is repealed and recreated to read:

NR 10.24(4)(g) All hunting permits are reservable and nontransferable. SECTION 5. NR 10.24(6)(a) and (b) are repealed and recreated to read:

NR 10.24(6)(a) The open season and limits for hunting and trapping are established in s. NR 10.01 except the limits for pheasant hunting which shall

be:

1. Daily bag - one, either sex for the first 14 days; 2, either sex thereafter.

 Possession - one the first day and double the daily bag limit thereafter.

(b) The daily opening of hunting hours for waterfowl and deer are established in s. NR 10.06.

SECTION 6. NR 10.24(6)(c) is renumbered NR 10.24(6)(e).

SECTION 7. NR 10.24(6)(c) and (d) are created to read:

NR 10.24(6)(c) The daily opening of hunting hours shall be in accordance with ss. NR 10.01 and 10.06 except during the pheasant season. During the pheasant season the daily opening of hunting hours shall be as follows:

1. Waterfowl and deer hunting shall be in accordance with ss. NR 10.01 and 10.06.

Pheasant hunting and all other species except waterfowl and deer hunting:

a. The Saturday nearest October 17 - in accordance with ss. NR 10.01 and 10.06.

b. The Sunday nearest October 17 and running for 13 consecutive days 8:00 a.m. C.S.T.

c. Beginning with the 15th day of the pheasant season and thereafter in accordance with ss. NR 10.01 and 10.06.

3. Beginning in 1986, the daily opening of hunting hours for all species shall be the hours established in ss. NR 10.01 and 10.06.

(d) The daily closing of hunting hours for all species is established ins. NR 10.06 except during pheasant season when all hunting shall end at 2:00p.m. after the Saturday nearest October 17.

SECTION 8. NR 15.022 (intro.) is amended to read:

<u>NR 15.022 NO ENTRY GAME REFUGE (OCT. 1-NOV. 30) EXCEPT GUN DEER</u>. (intro.) A game refuge is established in the following areas when posted with department signs and no person may hunt waterfowl at any time, or enter such areas for any reason from October 1 through November 30 except <u>to hunt deer</u> during the open season for hunting deer established in s. NR 10.01(3)(e), <u>trapping by permit in the area described in sub. (5)</u>, and except for the retrieval of legally killed or crippled game in posted retrieval zones.

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SECTION 9. NR 45.12(1)(e) is repealed.

SECTION 10. NR 45.12(1)(f)5. is created to read:

NR 45.12(1)(f)5. For off-road motorcycles as defined in s. NR 45.03(15) and mopeds, when trailered or towed into the property and motor-powered hang gliders (commonly called ultralights) flown or trailered into the property for operation in the special use zone of the Bong state recreation area.

SECTION 11. NR 45.12(4)(f)1. and 2. are repealed and recreated to read:

NR 45.12(4)(f)1. Special use zone. The zone shall be available to groups for special events by reservation for \$25.00 per event. The reservation fee is nonrefundable.

2. Hunting zone. A vehicle admission sticker, hunting and trapping license as well as hunting and trapping administrative fees are required for hunting and trapping in the Bong state recreation area.

a. Pheasant hunting

\$3.00/person/day

In the event pheasant stocking cannot be done on the previous day or days, the pheasant hunting fee will be \$1.00/person/day.

b.	All other hunting	\$1. 00/person/day
с.	Trapping	\$10.00 per season
d.	Reservations	No fee

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SECTION 12. NR 45.13(18)(b)1.e. is repealed.

SECTION 13. NR 45.13(18)(b)2.d.3)a) is amended to read:

NR 45.13(18)(b)2.d.3)a) The first 3 weekends of January, February and weekends in December following the close of pheasant season.

SECTION 14. NR 45.13(18)(b)2.d.4) (intro.) and a) are amended to read:

NR 45.13(18)(b)2.d.4)(intro.) Hunting, dog trials, and dog training on foot.

a) The first 2 days and the following weekend of the waterfowl
and-pheasant season.

SECTION 15. NR 45.13(18)(b)2.d.4)e) is renumbered to NR 45.13(18)(b)2.e. and amended to read:

NR 45.13(18)(b)2.e. The zone shall be available to groups on a first-come, first-served basis <u>consistent with the scheduling calendar</u> if not previously reserved except for those days designated in subpar. d.4) <u>prior to</u> 2:00 p.m. daily during the pheasant season.

SECTION 16. NR 45.13(18)(b)2.d.4)f) is renumbered to NR 45.13(18)(b)2.f.

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The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on April 25, 1984.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats.
