ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE STATE OF WISCONSIN RENUMBERING, AMENDING AND CREATING A RULERECEIVED AND FILED

Relating to standards for disability insurance sold to medicard 1984

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE
The purpose of these changes is to permit health maintenance
organizations as defined in s. 628.36 (2m) (a), Stats., as affected by
1983 Wisconsin Acts 27 and 321, to offer a Medicare supplement which has
limitations on the choice of providers and the geographical area in which
coverage is provided; which is appropriately captioned and designated;
and which discloses territorial and provider limitations, restrictions on
emergency and urgent care services and information on how to file a claim
for these services. Ins 3.27 interprets ss. 628.34 and 601.01 (3),
Stats. Ins 3.39 interprets ss. 185.893 (1m), 601.01 (2), 625.16, 628.34
(12), 628.38, 631.20 (2), 632.73 (2m), 632.76 (2) and 632.81. Stats.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Commissioner of Insurance by ss. 601.41 (3) and 628.38, Stats., the Commissioner hereby creates Wisconsin Administrative Code s. Ins 3.27 (10) (j) 43 which implements and interprets ss. 628.34, Stats., renumbers, amends and creates sections of Ins 3.39 which implement and interpret ss. 185.893 (1m), 628.34 (12) and 628.38, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. Ins 3.27 (10) (j) 43 is created to read:

Ins 3.27 (10) (j) 43. Limitations on the choice of providers or geographical area served.

SECTION 2. Ins 3.39 (4) (a) 9. is renumbered Ins 3.39 (4) (a) 10.

SECTION 3. Ins 3.39 (4) (a) 9 is created to read:

Ins 3.39 (4) (a) 9 Prominently discloses any limitations on the choice of providers or geographical area of service.

SECTION 4. Ins 3.39 (5) and (6) (a) 6. are amended to read:

Ins 3.39 (5) AUTHORIZED MEDICARE SUPPLEMENT OR CERTIFICATE

DESIGNATIONS, CAPTIONS, AND MINIMUM COVERAGES. For a policy or

certificate to meet the requirements of sub. (4), it shall contain the

authorized designation, caption and minimum coverage prescribed for one

of the following categories of medicare supplement insurance. A health

maintenance organization as defined in s. 628.36 (2m) (a), Stats., shall

place the letters HMO in front of the required designation on any

approved medicare supplement policy.

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Ins 3.39 (6) (a) 6. If issued by a voluntary nonprofit sickness care plan or a health maintenance organization as defined by s. 628.36 (2m)

(a), Stats., include territorial limitations which are generally applicable to all coverage issued by the plan.

SECTION 5. Ins 3.39 Appendix (3) (c), (5) (j), and (6) (c) are created to read:

Ins 3.39 Appendix (3) (c) (If the insurer has contracted with the federal government to provide medicare benefits, the disclosure required in pars. (a) and (b) may be modified to describe this relationship accurately.)

Ins 3.39 Appendix (5) (j) Coverage for care received outside the service area if this care is treated differently than other covered benefits.

Ins 3.39 Appendix (6) (c) (That there are limitations on the choice of providers or the geographical area served, if this is the case.)

SECTION 6. Ins 3.39 Appendix (8) is renumbered Appendix (9).

SECTION 7. Ins 3.39 Appendix (8) is created to read:

Ins 3.39 Appendix (8) If the coverage is provided by a health maintenance organization defined under s. 628.36 (2m) (a), Stats., the outline of coverage shall prominently disclose all restrictions associated with the use of emergency and urgent care services and information on how to file a claim for services received outside the service area.

These changes shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026 (1) (intro.), Stats.
