IN THE MATTER OF RENUMBERING s. NR 10.01(3)(e)1.d.;  
 amending s. NR 10.01(3)(c)1.a.; repealing and  
 recreating ss. NR 10.01(3)(e)2.b. and  
 10.01(3)(e)3.; and creating s. NR 10.01(3)(e)1.d.  
 pertaining to the 1984 deer season.

Deer Season for Zone C - This proposal adds 2 days of antlerless deer hunting by permit to Green and Lafayette Counties' 3-day Hunter Choice Permit system and establishes an identical 5-day framework for that part of Iowa County south of U.S. Highway 18 (formerly 9-day buck deer only).

Deer Season Firearm Option - This proposal establishes a 2-day, shotgun only deer season followed by a 7-day firearm season in Buffalo County. Currently, rifles are not allowed for gun deer hunting. A public petition received by the Department requesting the change is consistent with the firearm rules in adjoining counties.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.174(1) and 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby renumbers, amends, repeals and recreates and creates rules interpreting s. 29.174(1), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 10.01(3)(e)1.a. is amended to read:

Shotgun season beginning on the Saturday preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 9 consecutive days	One buck deer per season with an antler not less than 3 inches in length or hunter's choice permit limit

Shotgun season beginning on the Saturday immediately preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 2 consecutive days

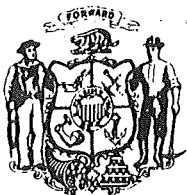
