# ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD RENUMBERING, AMENDING, REPEALING AND RECREATING AND CREATING RULES

RECEIVED

IN THE MATTER OF RENUMBERING s. NR 10.01(3)(e)1.d.; amending s. NR 10.01(3)(c)1.a.; repealing and recreating ss. NR 10.01(3)(e)2.b. and 10.01(3)(e)3.;and creating s. NR 10.01(3)(e)1.d. pertaining to the 1984 deer season.

### Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Deer Season for Zone C - This proposal adds 2 days of antlerless deer hunting by permit to Green and Lafayette Counties' 3-day Hunter Choice Permit system and establishes an identical 5-day framework for that part of Iowa County south of U.S. Highway 18 (formerly 9-day buck deer only).

Deer Season Firearm Option - This proposal establishes a 2-day, shotgun only deer season followed by a 7-day firearm season in Buffalo County. Currently, rifles are not allowed for gun deer hunting. A public petition received by the Department requesting the change is consistent with the firearm rules in adjoining counties.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.174(1) and 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby renumbers, amends, repeals and recreates and creates rules interpreting s. 29.174(1), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 10.01(3)(e)1.a. is amended to read:

### Kind of animal and locality

NR 10.01(3)(e)1.a. In the counties or parts of counties of Brown, Buffale (north-of-U.S.-highway-10), Calumet. Chippewa (south of state highway 64 and west of U.S. highway 53), Dodge (north of state highway 60), Door (Washington, Detroit, Plum and Rock islands), Dunn (south of state highway 64), Fond du Lac, Kewaunee, Manitowoc, Outagamie, Ozaukee (north of state highway 60 and county highway Q), Pepin (north of U.S. highway 10), St. Croix (south of state highway 64), Sheboygan, Shawano (south of state highway 29), Washington (north of state highway 60), Waupaca, and Winnebago.

## Open season (all dates inclusive)

Shotgun season beginning on the Saturday preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 9 consecutive days

One buck deer per season with an-antler not-less-than 3-inches-in length or hunter's choice permit limit.

SECTION 2. NR 10.01(3)(e)1.d. is renumbered 10.01(3)(e)1.e.

Open season (all dates inclusive)

NR 10.01(3)(e)1.d. All that part of Buffalo county north of U.S. highway 10

Shotgun season beginning on the Saturday immediately preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 2 consecutive days

Firearm season beginning on the day immediately after the season described above and continuing for 7 consecutive days

One buck deer per season or hunter's choice permit limit with shotgun or firearm

SECTION 4. NR 10.01(3)(e)2.b. is repealed and recreated to read:

Kind of animal and locality

Open season (all dates inclusive)

NR 10.01(3)(e)2.b. In the counties of Buffalo (south of U.S. highway 10), Jackson (south of state highway 71 and the Black river), La Crosse, Monroe (south of highway 71 and west of state highway 27), and Trempealeau (west and south of state highways 93 and 121, and U.S. highways 10 and 53).

Shotgun season beginning on the Saturday immediately preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 2 consecutive days

Firearm season
beginning on the day

above and continuing
for 7 consecutive
days

One deer per season, either sex with shotguns; one buck deer per season with firearms

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats.
