ORDER OF THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION AMENDING RULES

1 To amend PI 3.07(7)(a)2a and PI 3.07(7)(a)3a, relating to the reading

2 teacher and reading specialist license.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Public Instruction

The proposed rules interpreting s. 115.28(7), Stats., will delay the effective date of the new reading teacher and reading specialist certification requirements until July 1, 1985. The requirements for obtaining the reading teacher and the reading specialist license were orginally scheduled to change as of July 1, 1984. However, the universities have been unable to implement the program changes within the nine months since the original rule order was filed. Consequently, those students graduating in 1984 and applying for certification as a reading teacher or reading specialist after July 1, 1984, have not completed the necessary coursework under the new certification rules. Implementation of this rule as of July 1, 1984, would mean students would probably have to spend additional time in school in order to meet the new requirements. The change of the effective date to July 1, 1985, will give universities ample time to implement the program changes and will give students ample time to complete the necessary coursework.
