

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing and recreating .
section NR 46.09(2)(a), (b) and (c) of .

pertaining to the stumpage values for .
severance tax under the Forest Crop Law. .

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The revisions to section NR 46.09(2), Wis. Admin. Code repeal and recreate annual stumpage values for the purpose of calculating severance tax due on timber cut from Forest Crop Law lands as of November 1, 1984, as required by s. 77.06(2), Stats. There are five separate severance schedule zones reflecting varying stumpage prices for different species and products across the state. This makes it possible to levy severance taxes which more nearly represent 10% of the actual stumpage value which is the basic legislative intent.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 77.06(2) and 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals and recreates rules interpreting s. 77.06(2), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 46.09(2)(a), (b) and (c) are repealed and recreated to read:
