ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of creating s. NR 5.33(2)(f); . and amending s. NR 5.34(3) of the Wisconsin . Administrative Code pertaining to . LE-7-84 regulating water use on the Lower . St. Croix River in Pierce and St. Croix . Counties .

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The proposed rule would add four slow-no-wake buoys which would increase the slow-no-wake zone at the mouth of the Kinnickinnic River. Numerous boats anchor over-night in this area and people are swimming, rowing small boats or air mattresses and tubes between the boats and shore. High speed boats and water skiing make this a very dangerous situation.

The existing ban on water skiing on Saturday, Sunday and holidays would be extended to May 15 through September 15. It is presently Memorial Day through Labor Day. This extension would cover Memorial Day weekend as well as the heavy use period several weeks before Memorial Day and after Labor Day.

This rule does not regulate small businesses.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 30.72 and 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends and creates rules interpreting s. 30.72, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 5.33(2)(f) is created to read:

(f) In the bay formed by the Kinnickinnic river delta, north and east of Donut island, at mile 6.0.

SECTION 2. NR 5.34(3) is amended to read:

(3) From <u>Memorial Day through Labor Day, inclusive</u>, <u>May 15 through</u> <u>September 15</u>, no motorboat towing a person on water skis, aquaplane or similar device shall <u>may</u> operate after 12:00 noon on Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays, from the sandbars located at mile 31.0 to the upper end of the federal 9-foot navigation channel at mile 24.5. The foregoing rule was approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on June 27, 1984.

The rule contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1) (intro.), Stats.
