PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE : EXAMINING BOARD REPEALING,
MEDICAL EXAMINING BOARD : AMENDING OR ADOPTING RULES

ORDER

Pursuant to authority vested in the Medical Examining Board in ss. 15.08(5)(b), 227.014(2)(a), 448.05 and 448.40, Stats., the Medical Examining Board hereby repeals and recreates Med 1.07(2), interpreting ss. 448.05 and 448.40, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. Med 1.07(2) is repealed and recreated to read:

Med 1.07(2) At the beginning of the examinations a proctor shall read and distribute to the applicants the rules of conduct to be followed during the examinations and the consequences of violation of the rules. If an applicant violates the rules of conduct, the board may withhold or invalidate the applicant's examination scores, disqualify the applicant from the practice of medicine or impose other appropriate discipline.

The rule repealed and recreated in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.026, Stats.
