ORDER OF THE WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD  
AMENDING, AND REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER OF amending ss. NR 10.001(23),  
10.01(2)(f), 10.25(1)(c)2. and 10.25(3);  
and repealing and recreating s. NR 10.29  
of the Wisconsin Administrative Code  
pertaining to regulation modifications for  
the 1985 wild turkey hunting season.

Analysis Prepared by the  
Department of Natural Resources

1. Turkey Hunting Permits - The number of turkey hunting permits controls the turkey harvest and hunting pressure in 5 Wild Turkey Hunting Zones for 3 separate hunting periods. The Department proposes to increase the number of permits to be issued for the 1985 hunting season by 225 based upon the experience obtained during the 1984 season. In 1984, 1,950 permits were issued and 308 wild turkeys were harvested.
2. Housekeeping Modifications - Four minor rule modifications are proposed for clarification purposes and to improve hunter service: a) the definition of bearded turkey is used to eliminate awkward rule text, b) the east boundary of Zone 10 is modified to better reflect turkey range, c) the permit application deadline is delayed from October 1 to the first Friday in November to provide applicants more time for application, and d) the daily registration deadline is shortened from 3 p.m. to 1:30 p.m. to save Department costs; few hunters register wild turkeys beyond noon.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.103, 29.174(2)(b), 227.014(2)(a) and 227.02(1)(e), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends, and repeals and recreates rules interpreting s. 29.103, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 10.001(23) is amended to read:

NR 10.001(23) "Male Bearded turkey" means a turkey with a beard, a bristle-like appendage protruding from the upper part of the breast.

SECTION 2. NR 10.01(2)(f) is amended to read:

(f) <u>Wild turkey</u>		
1. Zones 1, 2, 4, 9 and 10 as described in s. NR 10.29 are <u>open zones</u> . Zones 3, 5, 6, 7 and 8 are closed zones.	Beginning on the Thursday nearest April 21 and continuing Thursday through Monday for 3 consecutive time periods shown in subd. 2.	One male or <u>bearded turkey</u> per season by permit.

SECTION 3. NR 10.25(1)(c)2. is amended to read:


NR 10.25(1)(c)2. All application forms must be postmarked no later than ~~October-7~~ the first Friday in November to be considered for the succeeding wild turkey hunting season.

SECTION 4. NR 10.25(3) is amended to read:

NR 10.25(3) REGISTRATION. A person who possesses a wild turkey shall exhibit and register the bird at a department registration station no later than 3:00 1:30 p.m. on the day killed. The department shall affix a registration tag to lawfully taken wild turkeys and the tag shall be kept with the turkey until the turkey meat is consumed.

SECTION 5. NR 10.29 is repealed and recreated to read:

NR 10.29 WILD TURKEY HUNTING ZONES. Wild turkey hunting zones are established as designated on the following map:



The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on September 26, 1984.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats.


