ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN LAKE MICHIGAN COMMERCIAL FISHING BOARD RENUMBERING, AMENDING, AND CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of renumbering s. NR 25.07(2)(a)3.d.; amending s. NR 25.07(1)(a)3.c.; and creating s. NR 25.07(2)(a)3.d. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to allocation of the commercial chub harvest in southern Lake Michigan.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

The repeal and recreation of s. NR 25.07(2)(a)3.d., Wis. Adm. Code, is necessary to provide room for created s. NR 25.07(2)(a)3.d., Wis. Adm. Code, and to maintain a logical sequence in these rules.

The amendment to s. NR 25.07(2)(a)3.c., Wis. Adm. Code, provides an exception in reference to created s. NR 25.07(2)(a)3.d., Wis. Adm. Code.

The creation of s. NR 25.07(2)(a)3.d., Wis. Adm. Code, provides for one year transfer of up to 50% of an allotted chub quota between licensees holding allotted chub quotas, with a "sunset" clause of January 1, 1986.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Lake Michigan Commercial Fishing Board by s. 29.33(7), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Lake Michigan Commercial Fishing Board hereby renumbers, amends and creates rules as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 25.07(2)(a)3.c. is amended to read:

NR 25.07(2)(a)3.c. No more than the amount of one maximum individual quota allotted under subpar. a.l) and 2) may be taken on any one boat in the southern chub zone during the license year except as provided under subpar.

d. If it is necessary to transfer a chub fishing permit to another boat, this limit shall be applied in total on the boats involved.

SECTION 2. NR 25.07(2)(a)3.d. is renumbered 25.07(2)(a)3.e.

....

SECTION 3. NR 25.07(2)(a)3.d. is created to read:

NR 25.07(2)(a)3.d. Ay permittee with an individual chub quota allotment under subpar. a.1) and 2) may transfer up to 50% of their allotted chub quota to another permittee with an individual chub quota allotment under subpar. a.1) and 2).

- 1) Such a quota transfer shall be in effect only during the current license year, and shall be subject to sub. (6).
- 2) The total amount of chubs harvested from the boat designated under subd. 1.b. by the transferor may not exceed the amount remaining in that individual chub quota allotment after this transfer.
- 3) This subparagraph shall be in effect until January 1, 1986, and shall be reviewed while in effect by the Lake Michigan commercial fishing board.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the Lake Michigan Commercial Fishing Board on October 18, 1984.

The foregoing rules were approved by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on November 14, 1984.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats.
