AN ORDER to amend Ind 69.09 (1) (a) 1. a., (b), (c) (intro.), (c) 4., (d), (e) and (g) to (k), and Tables Ind 69.09-1 and 69.09-2; and to create Ind 69.09 (1) (a) 1. c., relating to the fee schedule for the examination of building plans charged by the Division of Safety and Buildings.

ANALYSIS OF RULES

Pursuant to s. 101.12, Stats., the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations has the responsibility to examine plans for public buildings, public structures and places of employment in order to determine compliance with the state Building, Heating and Ventilating and Air Conditioning Code, chapters ILHR 50-64. The department, by administrative rule, establishes and collects fees for providing this service.

The last time the fees for plan examination were revised commercial building activity was very weak and the fees were set at rates which would provide sufficient revenues to maintain this department service. Now that commercial construction has increased and is projected to continue to grow at a modest rate, the department would realize a significant surplus of revenue if the existing fees were to remain in place. Therefore, the department is proposing to reduce the fees it charges for the examination of building plans.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin, Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by ss. 101.02 (1) and 101.19, Stats., the department hereby amends and creates rules interpreting s. 101.19 (1) (a), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 2. Ind 69.09 (1) (a) 1. a. is amended to read:

Ind 69.09 (1) (a) 1. a. Warehouses. The fees for plan examination of warehouses shall be determined in accordance with par. (a) (intro.) except that the fee may be reduced by 30%. The minimum fee shall be \$75.00 \$60.00.

SECTION 3. Ind 69.09 (1) (a) 1. c. is created to read:

Ind 69.09 (1) (a) 1. c. Examination fees for multiple identical buildings at the same site. The fees outlined in this subparagraph may be applied to a project which contains multiple identical buildings. In order to qualify for this fee, the plans for all buildings shall be submitted at the same time and construction of all buildings shall commence within 12 months from the date of approval issued by the department. Approval shall expire for all buildings not started within 12 months of approval. The plans shall be submitted in one of the following ways: building, heating, ventilating and air conditioning and illumination; or building; or heating, ventilating and air conditioning. Illumination plans shall be submitted with either the building or heating, ventilating and air conditioning plans. The fees for the examination of building and heating and ventilating plans for the first building shall be computed from the fees set forth in Table 69.09-1 on the basis of the total volume of one building. The fees for the examination of the remaining buildings shall be computed on the basis of \$60.00 for each identical building for building plans and \$60.00 for each identical building for heating and ventilating plans. The examination fee for illumination plans shall be computed on the basis of \$10.00 for 2 identical buildings and \$15.00 for 3 or more identical buildings.

SECTION 4. Ind 69.09 (1) (b) is amended to read:

Ind 69.09 (1) (b) Permit to start construction. The fee for a permit to start construction shall be \$75.00 \$60.00 per permit.

SECTION 5. Ind 69.09 (1) (c) (intro.) is amended to read:

Ind 69.09 (1) (c) <u>Building alterations</u>. The examination fees for alteration plans of existing buildings and structures undergoing remodeling or review of tenant space layouts shall be computed on the basis of 2 cents per gross square foot of the floor area, roof areas and external wall surfaces undergoing remodeling. The minimum fee shall be \$75.00 \$60.00.

SECTION 6. Ind 69.09 (1) (c) 4. is amended to read:

Ind 69.09 (1) (c) 4. Where heating, ventilating and air conditioning alteration plans are submitted separately from the building alteration plans, the examination fees shall be computed on the basis of \$3.24 per \$1,000 cost of the alteration. The minimum fee shall be \$75.00 \$60.00.

SECTION 7. Ind 69.09 (1) (d) and (e) are amended to read:

Ind 69.09 (1) (d) Revisions. The fee for revisions to previously examined plans is \$75.00 \$60.00 per plan. This paragraph applies when plans are revised for reasons other than those that were requested by the department.

(e) <u>Footing and foundation plans</u>. The fee for a footing and foundation plan submitted separately is \$108.00 \$90.00 per plan.

SECTION 8. Table 69.09-2 is amended to read:

SECTION 9. Ind 69.09 (1) (g) to (k) is amended to read:

Ind 69.09 (1) (g) Fire escapes. The fee for fire escapes is \$49.00 per plan.

- (h) Stadia, grandstands and bleachers. The fee for stadia, grandstands and bleachers is \$19.00 per 1000 seats or fraction of 1000 seats, with a minimum fee of \$49.00 \$40.00.
- (i) Industrial exhaust systems for dusts, fumes, vapors and gases (government owned only). The fee for industrial exhaust systems for dusts, fumes, vapors and gases is \$49.00 \$40.00 per plan.
- (j) Spray booth plans (government owned only). The fee for spray booth plans is \$49.00 \$40.00 per plan.
- (k) <u>Miscellaneous plans</u>. The fee for miscellaneous plans such as canopies, a building's structure for "fast track" construction, and approval requests for structures cited in s. ILHR 50.12 (1) (a) 1., is \$75.00 \$60.00 per plan.
