ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN
LAKE SUPERIOR COMMERCIAL FISHING BOARD
REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

.....
IN THE MATTER of repealing and recreating .
s. NR 25.07(1)(a) of the Wisconsin .
Administrative Code pertaining to . F-41-84
allocation of individual licensee catch .
quotas for lake trout on Lake Superior .

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

The repeal and recreation of s. NR 25.07(1)(a), Wis. Adm. Code, changes the allocation of individual licensee catch quotas for Lake Superior lake trout from a given poundage based on the type of nets used, to a system where all licensees share equally. In practice, this is what is done now as all licensees use gill nets to qualify for the higher quota based on the existing rules. The method used for determining the number of lake trout tags needed for an individual licensee quota is described.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Lake Superior Commercial Fishing Board by s. 29.33(7), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Lake Superior Commercial Fishing Board hereby repeals and recreates rules interpreting s. 29.33, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 25.07(1)(a) is repealed and recreated to read:

NR 25.07(1)(a) Lake trout. 1. Each licensed commercial fisher shall receive an equal share of the annual Lake trout harvest quota established under s. NR 25.06(1)(a)2.

2. Allocation of the lake trout quota to individual licensees shall be by issuance of appropriate tags by the department. The number of tags issued to each individual licensee shall be based on the average dressed weight of individual lake trout commercially harvested during the previous year.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the Lake Superior Commercial Fishing Board on October 16, 1984.

The foregoing rules were approved by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on November 14, 1984.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on July 1, 1985.

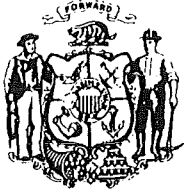


