ORDER OF THE
PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION
ADOPTING RULES



To amend s. PSC 165.052(2)(e), relating to disconnection of local telephone service for failure to pay a toll bill.

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN

On December 11, 1984, the Public Service Commission of Statutes held hearing into modification of sec. PSC 165.052(2)(c), Wis. Sureau Adm. Code, which presently allows disconnection of a customer's local telephone service for failure to pay a toll telephone bill.

The modification originally proposed would have ended this provision as of June 1, 1987. The amendment now being adopted varies slightly from that proposal by allowing a toll carrier or local exchange provider the opportunity to show that ending that termination option would constitute "a significant hardship to the detriment of ratepayers."

PROPOSED RULE AND STATUTORY AUTHORITY

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service

Commission by §§196.02(1), 196.03, 196.37(2), 227.014(2)(a), and

227.027, Stats., and interpreting those provisions, the commission adopts the following rule:

SECTION 1: PSC 165.052(2)(e) is amended to read:

(2)(e) Failure to pay a delinquent toll account billed by the utility providing local exchange service, provided the utility is authorized by the toll carrier to resolve customer disputes.

Commencing June 1, 1987, no provider of local exchange service shall disconnect local service for nonpayment of another carrier's toll bill unless either the toll carrier or the local exchange provider can demonstrate to the commission significant hardship to the detriment of ratepayers.

There will be no fiscal impact of the proposed rule on the state or municipalities, and no significant economic impact on small business.

This is a Type 3 WEPA action pursuant to PSC 2.90(3), Wis. Adm. Code. In addition, no unusual circumstances have come to the commission which would warrant further environmental review. It consequently requires neither an environmental impact statement under s.l.ll, Wis. Stats., nor an environmental assessment.

These rules have been reviewed by the legislature pursuant to s. 227.018, Stats. They will take effect as final rules on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register, as provided in s. 227.026, Stats.
