ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
AMENDING RULES

.....
IN THE MATTER of amending s. NR 30.01(1)(1) .
of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining .
to the establishment of an intensive . FO-52-84
fire protection zone in the towns of Green .
Valley, Texas, Emmet, Marathon, Halsey, .
Hamburg, Berlin and Maine in Marathon County .

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

On April 13, 1982, the Town of Emmet, Marathon County, petitioned the Department to extend intensive forest fire protection over the entire Town of Emmet.

On June 13, 1983, the Town Board of Texas, Marathon County passed a motion to include the entire Town of Texas under intensive forest fire protection.

On May 31, 1983, the Green Valley Town Board passed a resolution to extend intensive forest fire protection over the entire Town of Green Valley.

A study was conducted by the Department to determine if additional lands should be included in intensive protection. The study concluded that the remainder of the townships of Halsey, Hamburg, Marathon, Berlin, Easton and some additional land in Maine all in Marathon County should be placed under intensive protection.

The proposed rule will extend intensive forest fire protection to cover these townships except for areas inside city limits and incorporated villages. These townships are in the Antigo fire control area and will be assigned to the DNR fire control ranger station at the base of Rib Mountain.

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 26.11, 26.12 and 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends a rule interpreting s. 26.12, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 30.01(1)(1) is amended to read:

NR 30.01(1)(1) Marathon county. All lands in: all that part of township 26 north, range 5 east lying east of county trunk "S"; all of township 26 north, ranges 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 east; all of that part of township 27 north, range 5 east lying east of county trunk highway "S"; all of township 27 north, ranges 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 east; all of township 28 north, range 6 east, east 1/3; all of township 28 north, range 7 east, except those lands lying easterly of the Wisconsin river and the Big Rib river in sections 1, 2, 3, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 24; township 28 north, range 8 east, south 1/3; all of township 28 north, ranges 9 and 10 east; township 29 north, range 7 east, that portion of sections 3 and 4 lying north of county trunk highway "W", section 1 and that portion of sections 2 and 12 lying east of the Wisconsin river; all of that part of township 29 north, range 9 east lying east of county trunk highway "Q"; all of township 29 north, range 10 east; all of township 30 north, range 3 east; all of that part of township 30 north, range 4 east, lying north of county trunk highways "F" and "H"; all of township 30 north, range 5 east lying north of county trunk highway "A"; township 30 north, range 6 east, north 1/3; all of township 30 north, range 7 east except sections 17, 20, 29, 30, 31 and 32 and that portion of section 36 lying east of county 18, 19, trunk highway "W"; all of township 30 north, range 8 east, except that of sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 that are south of county trunk highway portion "W" and the town highway known as the "Granite road"; all of township 30 north, ranges 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 east.

The foregoing rule was approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin
Natural Resources Board on March 27, 1985.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1)
(intro.), Stats.

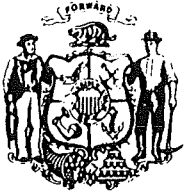


