ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING RULES

IN THE MATTER of amending ss. NR 25.05(1)(d) and 25.07(2)(a)3.b.2) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to commercial harvest of chubs in Lake Michigan

F-57-84

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

The amending of s. NR 25.05(1)(d), Wis. Adm. Code, changes the opening of the chub season in the southern chub fishing zone from April 1 to March 15. Department studies have shown that this can be done without damaging chub stocks or reproduction. This earlier opening would be financially beneficial to the commercial fishers as it will allow them to take advantage of the Lenten market. Section NR 25.07(2)(a)3.b.2), Wis. Adm. Code, is amended to make the periods described conform to the new chub season outlined in amended s. NR 25.05(1)(d), Wis. Adm. Code.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.085, 29.174, 29.33, 227.014(2)(a) and 227.027, Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules interpreting ss. 29.085, 29.174 and 29.33, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 25.05(1)(d) is amended to read:

A B C
Species Green Bay Lake Michigan Lake Superior

(d) Chubs No open season

April 1 to December 31 At all times in the northern chub fishing zone, and March 15 to December 31 in the southern chub fishing zone, subject to ss. NR 25.06(2)(a), 25.07(2)(a) and 25.09

SECTION 2. NR 25.07(2)(a)3.b.2) is amended to read:

NR 25.07(2)(a)3.b.2) No permittee may take more than 40% of the maximum amount established in subpar. b.l) during any one of the 3-menth-fishing quota periods encompassed-by-the-menths of July;-August-and 1 through September 30, the-menths-ef October;-Nevember-and 1 through December 31, and-the-menths-ef April;-May-and or March 15 through June 30 respectively.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on December 12, 1984.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats.
