# ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD RENUMBERING AND CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of renumbering s. NR 19.001(1);
and creating ss. NR 19,001(1) and (2) and 19:01
of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining
to timelines for approvals under ch. 29, Stats.,
and for boating and snowmobiling

#### Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

The proposed rules are adopted to comply with s. 227.0105, Stats., (1983), which requires the establishment of time periods within which the department must make its decision on an application for a permit or approval required to conduct business. The proposed rules are designed to address the large number of fishing, guiding, raising wild animals, boating, snowmobiling, etc., permits and approvals governed by chs. 29 and 350 and ss. 30.52 to 30.54, Stats.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by s. 227.014(2)(a) Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby renumbers and creates rules interpreting s. 227.0105, Stats., (1983), as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter NR 19 is retitled "Miscellaneous Fur, Fish, Game and Outdoor Recreation."

SECTION 2. NR 19.001(1) is renumbered 19.001(3).

SECTION 3. NR 19.001(1) and (2) are created to read:

NR 19.001(1) "Application" means a written request for an approval required to do business in this state as defined in s. 560.41(2), Stats., completed in the form required by and acceptable to the department and accompanied by additional plans, information and the appropriate fee.

(2) "Approval" means a license, permit or other form of approval required from the department to conduct business activities in Wisconsin.

SECTION 4. NR 19.01 is created to read:

NR 19.01 APPROVAL DEADLINES. (1) GENERAL. Upon receipt of an application for an approval required to conduct business activities under ch. 29, ss. 30.50 to 30.54, 350.12 and 350.125, Stats., the department shall review and issue a decision on the application within 10 business days unless a different period is otherwise provided in subs. (2) to (6) or other statutes or rules.

(2) SPECIFIC APPROVAL DEADLINES. The following approvals will be acted on as follows:

(k)	Snowmobile licenses under ss. 350.12 and 350.125, Stats.	30						

(3) STANDARDS AND CONDITIONS. If the department requires standards or conditions to be met or complied with prior to issuance of an approval, the time periods for issuing an approval do not begin to run until the applicant has met such standards or conditions as determined by the department.

Example: An applicant for a wildlife exhibit, game, bird and animal farm, or deer farm license is required to meet pen specifications or fencing requirements before the time system for issuance of approvals begins to apply.

(4) <u>WILDLIFE SURVEYS</u>. If a survey of wildlife on the property is required, the time periods for issuing an approval do not apply until completion of that survey. The survey shall be completed within 30 business days from the time of year that, in the opinion of a professional department wildlife manager, is optimum for determining accurate wildlife populations. At the time the application is received, the department shall inform the applicant of the date by which the survey will be completed.

- (5) ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT. If an environmental impact analysis, environmental impact report or environmental impact statement is required under ss. 1.11 and 23.11(5), Stats., and ch. NR 150, the time periods for issuing an approval do not apply until ss. 1.11 and 23.11(5), Stats., and ch. NR 150 have been complied with.
- (6) OTHER APPROVALS. The time for an approval for an activity under sub. (1) will not begin to run until other approvals for that activity are obtained.
