# Analysis Prepared by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation

General summary of rule. Chapter Trans 250, Wis. Admin. Code, establishes general policies concerning the vehicle oversize and overweight permits authorized by ss. 348.25 to 348.27, Stats. Permits are issued to businesses under those statutory provisions and under chs. Trans 251 to 275 and Hy 30, Wis. Admin. Code. Thus, under s. 227.0105(1), Stats., as created by 1983 Wisconsin Act 91, the department of transportation is to revise ch. Trans 250 to specify the number of days within which the department will review and act upon applications for oversize or overweight permits. This rule requires the department to act upon applications within 30 days or, failing to do that, to report its failure to the department of development.

Fiscal effect. This rule change will not have any appreciable fiscal effect upon the state, local governments or any private business or person. It simply states what is already usual practice. It is in accordance with the requirements of s. 227.0105(1), Stats., and has no fiscal effect beyond that of existing statute.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Wisconsin department of transportation by ss. 85.16(1), 227.014(2), 227.0105(1), and 348.25(3), Stats., the department of transportation creates s. Trans 250.025, Wis. Admin. Code, as follows:

### RULE TEXT

SECTION 1. Section Trans 250.025, Wis. Admin. Code, is created to read:

Trans 250.025 PERMIT APPLICATIONS. (1) The department shall receive applications for the oversize and overweight permits authorized by ss. 348.25 to 348.27, Stats. Within 30 days after receiving a fully completed application and the required permit fees, the department shall review and shall either grant or deny the application.

(2) If the department fails to grant or deny an application within the 30 days, the department shall submit a report to the department of development, permit information center. The report shall satisfy the requirements of s. 227.0105(4), Stats., and shall identify the applicant and the applicant's business activity, explain briefly why the application was not reviewed and granted or denied within 30 days, state the time within which the department will complete its review and determination and describe how the department expects to avoid similar future delays.

[Note: The 30 days within which the department is to act shall be computed in accordance with s. 990.001(4), Stats. Thus, the date of application receipt is excluded. If the last day falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, the last day shall be the next day that is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday.]
