Analysis Prepared by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation

General summary of rule. These amendments to Trans 2 change the annual application deadline for a state and federally funded capital grant program from the first Monday in December to the first Monday in November. This change will not reduce the length of time in which an application may be prepared. Just as the application deadline is advanced by 30 days, so the distribution of the application materials and instructions will be made 30 days earlier than if the deadline were in December.

This change is made for two reasons. The first reason is to reduce the number of applications that must be handled in December. Currently department staff receive applications for this program as well as three other programs in December. As the number of applicants has increased, the burden of handling these applications has become too concentrated.

The second reason is to coordinate the grant process more appropriately with the production schedules of vehicle manufacturers. Program grants are made to acquire buses or vans for specialized transportation services for elderly and disabled persons. An earlier application deadline should make it possible for the department to seek bids earlier in a model year when the production of certain vehicles is less likely to be sold out.

Final Regulatory Flexibility Analysis. This rule change will not affect small businesses.

Fiscal Estimate. This rule change will have no fiscal effect upon the state, local governments or any private business or person.

Trans 2.05(1)(a) On or before the first Monday in Becember November, submit its completed application to the department's appropriate district office;
