ORDER OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD RENUMBERING, AMENDING, REPEALING AND RECREATING AND CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of renumbering ss. NR 10.12(5)(d)2.d., 10.27(2) to (4), and NR 15.023(3); amending ss. NR 10.21(2)(f)1. and 2.; repealing and recreating ss. NR 10.01(3)(e)7., (4)(a)3. and 10.29; and creating ss. NR 10.12(5)(d)2.d., 10.27(2) and 15.023(3) pertaining to hunting and trapping regulations.

Analysis Proposed by Department of Natural Resources

- Turkey hunting Department wild turkey re-stocking efforts have been very successful and a harvest in a larger area is warranted. The boundaries for zones 3 and 5 are adjusted to accommodate management needs.
- 2. Deer hunting Military officials desire to provide annual gun deer season flexibility by written agreement with the Department to minimize agricultural damage problems while optimizing recreational opportunities at Ft. McCoy (Monroe Co.) and Volk Field (Juneau Co.). The Department also proposes to establish deer hunting in 2 state parks for similar reasons.
- 3. Trapping zones Modifying the Mississippi River trapping zone slightly from state highway 35 to the Burlington Northern railway will increase trapping recreation because certain lands will be regulated by a more liberal trapping zone.
- 4. Non-toxic shot Research has verified that non-toxic (steel) shot regulations are needed in a portion of Burnett County to eliminate lead shot depositions and minimize lead poisoning risks for waterfowl.
- 5. Wildlife refuge Creating a 150-acre no entry waterfowl refuge on a state-owned wildlife area will provide a rest area for waterfowl during the hunting season.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.085, 29.103(3) and (4), 29.174(1), 29.57(4) and 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby renumbers, amends, repeals and recreates, and creates rules interpreting ss. 23.09(2)(k), 29.085, 29.103(3) and (4) and 29.174(1), Stats., as follows:

All that part of Burnett county enclosed by a line beginning at the intersection of state highways 48 and 70, then south on highway 48 to its intersection with county highway 0, then west on highway 0 to its intersection with the east bank of the St. Croix river, then north on the east bank of the St. Croix river to its intersection with state highway 70, then east on highway 70 to its intersection with state highway 48, then north on highway 48 and continuing north to its intersection with county highways D and F, then east on highway D to its intersection with county highway N, then south on highway N to state highway 70, then east on highway 70 to its intersection with state highway 35, then north on highway 35 to its intersection with county highway U, then west and north on highway U and continuing north on county highway FF to its intersection with county highway F, then west and south on highway F to the point of beginning.




 $\underline{\sf NR}$ 10.29 WILD TURKEY HUNTING ZONES. Wild turkey hunting zones are established as designated on the following map.
