Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Deer Management Unit 54B located in southern Adams and northern Sauk counties is divided into two parts to improve management effectiveness because harvest quotas will be applied to smaller geographic areas.


SECTION 1. NR 10.01(3)(e)9.e. is amended to read:


