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ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing and recreating s. NR 1.41 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to criteria for Natural . Resources Board approval of real estate transactions

RE-7-85

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Chapter NR 1, Wis. Adm. Code, contains rules on the Department of Natural Resources' management, acquisition and disposition of Department land. The proposed rule establishes the criteria for obtaining formal approval of the Natural Resources Board for the acquisition and sale of Department land. Further, the proposed rule requires the Department to submit to the Board (1) a yearly statistical report on the land control program, and (2) a monthly status report on all options and pending land acquisitions.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 15.05(1)(b) and 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the Natural Resources Board hereby repeals and recreates rules interpreting ss. 15.05(1)(b), 23.09(2)(d) and 23.15, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 1.41 is repealed and recreated to read:

NR 1.41 LAND TRANSACTION AUTHORIZATION. (1) The following land transactions of the department shall require board approval:

- (a) Acquisitions where the purchase price is \$150,000 or more.
- (b) Acquisitions where more than 40 acres are outside of an established project boundary.
- (c) Acquisitions where the purchase price exceeds the highest appraised value.

- (d) Acquisitions by condemnations of land.
- (e) Acquisitions by gifts of land to the department.
- (f) Acquisitions where improvement values exceed 35% of total appraised value.
 - (g) Acquisitions of short tenure with substantial increased value.
- (h) Sales of state land that are no longer needed for conservation purposes where the value exceeds \$50,000 or where the acreage exceeds 40 acres.
 - (2) The secretary may approve all other land transactions.
- (3) The department shall submit to the board a yearly statistical report on the land control program, including an analysis of the program's status in relationship to the state recreational plan.
- (4) The department shall submit to the board at each meeting a report on the status of all options and pending land acquisitions showing the date of each option.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on July 24, 1985

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats.
